BUSTER BAR DESSERT

- 1 15 OZ package of Oreo cookies/crushed
- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1/2 gallon vanilla ice cream
- 1 1/2 cups salted peanuts
- 2 Cups powdered sugar
- 1 Can evaporated milk
- 6 oz chocolate chips
- 1/2 Cup butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Add melted butter to cookie crumbs and pat into a 9x13 pan. Slice vanilla ice cream and put layers in pan. Sprinkle salted peanuts on ice cream; put in freezer. Combine sugar, milk, chips, and butter in saucepan. Boil for 8 minutes, add vanilla and let cool. When cooled, pour on top of ice cream and peanuts. Put back in freezer until ready to serve.
